Other languages of sources/works cited: Latin, Old English. , abstract: Much time and ink has been spent on the study of the so called Beowulf manuscript which nowadays constitutes the presumably 'most discussed' (LUCAS 1990: 363) Old English manuscript. Contained in this manuscript is the apocryphal Letter of Alexander to Aristotle that will be central to this paper. The multitude of medieval manuscripts (cf. GUNDERSON 1980: 48) of the Letter leave little doubt that it certainly belongs to some of the 'most successful literary impostures of the medieval ages' (RYPINS 1971: xliii). However, its Anglo-Saxon version 'has excited little attention over the years' (ORCHARD 1995: 116). Scholar's interest seems to have been much more with the study of the earlier Latin form of the manuscript (RYPINS 1971: xxx): the Epistola Alexandri ad Aristotelem,...
