

Students and their parents are therefore advised to take advantage of the facilities thus offered and to communicate with the Secretary of the Provincial Committee before finally settling upon a course of study in England. Much time is often lost in England if students have not decided on the profession they are to follow, before leaving India. Students are advised to bring with them letters of introduction, as there are many occasions when such letters will be found useful; and students who intend to join one of the Inns of Court, especially, should bring letters of recommendation to Barristers of five years standing in London. In every case testimonials of good character should be procured from principals or professors of colleges or other educational authorities.
