The inlet port I on one side and exhaust port G on the other side, each extend nearly half-way round the circumference of the cylinder. The sleeves are provided with corresponding ports H and F, shown also in figs. 42 and 43. When the motion of the sleeves brings the two sleeve ports H into line with the cylinder port I, the mixture of air and petrol vapour from the carburetter enters the cylinder freely. The sleeves are shown in this position in fig. 42. Similarly, when the two sleeve exhaust ports F register with the cylinder exhaust port G, the products of combustion can be expelled. Fig. 43 shows the sleeves full open to exhaust. Examination of the drawings will show that the sleeves project...
